DIVISION DEFINITIONS

Power — Excellent Skills

Competitive — Very Good Skills

Intermediate — Decent Skills

Novice — Recreational Skills

Mixed — A combination of all skill levels

Spiking permitted in Power, Competitive and Intermediate.

NO REFUNDS will be given after schedules are completed.

Players must be at least 18 years of age or a high school graduate.

League play will begin on **May 17, 2010**.

League Entry Fee: \$150.00 (after the deadline date = \$ 175.00*)

*Entries received after the deadline date are not guaranteed admission.

If at any time it is found that a roster turned in by a team is not 100% true, that team will be eliminated from the league and lose their entry fee.

Teams are guaranteed 8 games per season. A single elimination tournament will be played at the conclusion of league play. Only the top 4 teams advance to the tournament.

Game times may begin as early as 6:00 PM and as late as 10:10 PM on a given night. Game times are subject to the amount of games needed on each night. Efforts will be made to create a balanced schedule for each team, but not guaranteed.

If more teams enter than can be accommodated, teams that played in last year's **SUMMER LEAGUE** will have priority to enter. New teams will be added on first come, first serve basis. Space is limited, so be sure to get your entries in early.

Summer League Games will be played at the Highland Hills Park courts. Inclement weather games will be played at the Armory Gymnasium in Tower Park.

Team plaques will be awarded for league and tourney champions & runner-up.

League Champions: If teams play an uneven number of games, the team with the best win percentage will be declared the league champion. If there are multiple teams tied for either of the first or second place positions, head-to-head record will be used to determine the winner. If a winner cannot be determined by this process, all teams will be awarded plaques.

Any team that forfeits two games will be eliminated from the tournament.

Any person playing that is not on a team roster constitutes a forfeit.

A player may play on only one team per night. Players will not be permitted to play on more than one team on a given night—even if those teams are in different divisions.

Good sportsmanship must be shown at all times. Any player expelled from a game is automatically ineligible to participate in the next scheduled game. A player expelled for any type of physical violence will be suspended for the season.

Three players may be added to the roster the first 30 days of the **current season**. All changes must be made at the Recreation Office located on the 1st floor of the Armory Building. Max of 12 players per roster.

Ft. Thomas Recreation Department league rules are in effect. Rules are available at the Recreation office, gym office or on-line.
