The Red Devils organization has been in existence for over 50 years and is a member of the Northern Kentucky Youth Football League. The goal of our organization is to teach the fundamentals and discipline of football and cheerleading in a competitive environment.

There are several age divisions that the Red Devils compete in for both football and cheerleading.

Spirit Squad – Ages 4 & 5 (Cheerleading only)

Starters – Ages 6 & 7

Pee Wees – Age 8

Midgets – Age 9

Juniors – Age 10 & 11

Seniors – Age 12 & 13

Football:

The Starter Division is a non-competitive division and the scores and team records are not kept. It is at this level that the fundamentals of football – blocking, tackling, running, passing, etc. are first taught to young players. Starting at the Pee Wee division, different areas of the game of football such as punting, blitzing, stunting, etc are phased in. When a football player leaves the organization as a Senior, they are ready to excel at the high school level. The Pee Wee thru the Senior divisions are competitive where the score and team records are kept. The season culminates with an end of the year playoff leading up to the SuperBowl.

Cheerleading:

We practice 2-4 nights a week where we work on cheer basics: sidelines, chants, field cheers, jumps, tumbling and then a final competition routine for the NKYFL Cheer Competition. Cheerleading is a wonderful way for girls to build long lasting friendships while working on team work, and most of all, building self esteem and a feeling of accomplishment. Our youngest girls are spirit squad and starters; we work on fundamentals and simple fun cheers, jumps and games to help the girls get used to cheering and being a squad. As the girls get older we add to the cheers, jumps and routines as their abilities progress. Each squad has at least one coach and one team mom. We also promote mentoring of the younger girls by the older girls; this allows the older squads to share their knowledge and experience. We have loads of fun and love what we do, so come cheer on our boys and join this great organization.

As a member of the Northern Kentucky Youth Football League, all of our games are either played at our Mills Road complex or a local high school football field. Our Mills Road complex consists of two well maintained grass fields complete with grandstands, announcer and press booths, electronic scoreboards and a large concession stand. The local high school fields that we regularly play games on include Beechwood, Bellevue, Dayton, Dixie, Highlands, Holmes, Lloyd, Ludlow, Newport, Scott and Simon Kenton.
