Baptism: Baptism is a joyful event "by which men and women are freed from their sins... are configured to Christ by an indelible character, and are incorporated into the Church." (Canon 849 of the Code of Canon Law). People can be baptized as adults or infants. The preparation for adult baptism takes place in the process of the catechumenate, commonly known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, or RCIA. Any adult desiring baptism may call the office to begin this process. Preparation for infant baptism happens in baptism classes, generally held on the fourth Thursday evening of each month in the Parish Office. No child will be baptized at St. Catherine unless both parents have attended one of these classes in the last five years. Baptism of adults generally takes place on Holy Saturday night, while baptism of infants can take place on any Sunday. Since baptism "incorporates one into the Church," it is appropriate that the infant be baptized during a Sunday liturgy when the local Church is gathered. There are legitimate reasons for not wanting to have the baptism during a Sunday liturgy; in those cases, baptisms may be scheduled for a Sunday at 1:00 p.m.

Parish Membership - Requires an Active Response

Active members of St. Catherine of Siena Parish have registered and provided the Parish Office with the information needed to complete the census forms. Active members regularly participate in the Saturday evening or Sunday Liturgy at St. Catherine of Siena Parish. Active members invest themselves in the parish by participating in the annual Stewardship Program pledging and contributing time, talent and treasure as God calls them. Active members hold the parish in their daily prayers.

SACRAMENTAL PREP/CCD COORDINATOR:

After three years, Kip Perkins is stepping away from the position of Sacramental Prep/CCD Coordinator. Kip did an excellent job in this position, and I am very grateful for his enthusiasm, commitment and good work. We are now in need of a new Coordinator. The Coordinator works in collaboration with the Pastor and school personnel to run the CCD and sacramental preparation (First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation) programs. This is primarily an administrative position, although the Coordinator may also be required at times to fill in for an absent CCD teacher. The Coordinator must be Virtus certified, dependable and able to work without constant direct supervision. If you are interested in this paid position, contact the parish office.




