Baptism: Baptism is a joyful event "by which men and women are freed from their sins... are configured to Christ by an indelible character, and are incorporated into the Church." (Canon 849 of the Code of Canon Law). People can be baptized as adults or infants. The preparation for adult baptism takes place in the process of the catechumenate, commonly known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, or RCIA. Any adult desiring baptism may call the office to begin this process. Preparation for infant baptism happens in baptism classes, generally held on the fourth Thursday evening of each month in the Parish Office. No child will be baptized at St. Catherine unless both parents have attended one of these classes in the last five years. Baptism of adults generally takes place on Holy Saturday night, while baptism of infants can take place on any Sunday. Since baptism "incorporates one into the Church," it is appropriate that the infant be baptized during a Sunday liturgy when the local Church is gathered. There are legitimate reasons for not wanting to have the baptism during a Sunday liturgy; in those cases, baptisms may be scheduled for a Sunday at 1:00 p.m.

#### Parish Membership - Requires an Active Response

Active members of St. Catherine of Siena Parish have registered and provided the Parish Office with the information needed to complete the census forms. Active members regularly participate in the Saturday evening or Sunday Liturgy at St. Catherine of Siena Parish. Active members invest themselves in the parish by participating in the annual Stewardship Program pledging and contributing time, talent and treasure as God calls them. Active members hold the parish in their daily prayers.

#### **IN OUR PARISH**

**LENTEN FASTING AND ABSTINENCE** – The following is what the Church teaches regarding Lenten fasting and abstinence.

**Fasting** requires a Catholic from the 18th to the 59th birthday to reduce the amount of food eaten from normal. The Church defines this as one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Such fasting is obligatory on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

**Abstinence** requires a Catholic 14 years of age until death to abstain from eating meat on Fridays in honor of the Passion of Jesus on Good Friday. On the Fridays outside of Lent, Catholics in the U.S. may substitute a penitential or even a charitable practice of their own choosing.

The other traditional Lenten practice is prayer. Although there is no church regulation regarding it, it is a good practice to pick a new or additional way of praying during Lent.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** – Praying the Stations is a wonderful Lenten practice that is appropriate for the whole family. Children are never too young to expose to this beautiful way of praying and meditating on Christ's sacrifice for us. This Friday, which is Good Friday, Stations will be held at noon.

**CHANGE IN TIME OF EXPOSITION AND BENEDICTION** – Due to the Chrism Mass being held on Tuesday, April 4th, we will end our time of Exposition early with Benediction at 4:30 p.m. Confessions that evening will be canceled as will the Rosary. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend the Chrism Mass.

HOLY THURSDAY EXPOSITION – Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place in McCrystal Hall on Holy Thursday, beginning immediately after Mass and lasting until midnight. If you would like to spend an hour before the Blessed Sacrament as part of your Holy Week practices, please sign up for an hour time slot on the sign-up sheet which is at the Rossford Avenue entrance. We need two people for each of the following times: 8:30-9:30 p.m.; 9:30-10:30 p.m.; 10:30-11:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m.-midnight.


