### **Priority #1:**

Strengthen our Parish Community rooted in the Catholic faith and increase sense of Belonging

- 1. **Goal:** Increase the number of participants in Small Faith Groups by 20% within the next 12 months
- 2. **Goal:** Increase the number of parishioners who indicate they have a positive and spiritually meaningful Sunday experience by 50% by the next survey
- 3. **Goal:** 70% of parishioners are involved in at least one or more ministries/volunteer activities by 12/31/24, 80% by 12/31/25, and 100% by 12/31/26



# **Priority #2:**

Grow our Parish Community through the re-engagement of inactive members and evangelization to non-members

- 1. **Goal:** At least 85% of parishioners invite someone to join them for Mass, or another parish activity, more than once annually by Spring 2025
